The mission of the angel academy was to train candidates for supporting the various kingdoms throughout the universe. Each one had its own struggles, and needed particular knowledge of the makeup of the souls that were its citizens.

How to motivate the population for Good was a necessary course for all of the students. Those who would be working with the planet Earth were watching a video of a man trying to start a lawnmower. When the subject had been announced, there were some groans scattered throughout the class. One angel spoke up and asked in a somewhat whiny voice, "Why do we need to understand how this machine works?"

The mentor replied, "It is not the machine that cuts their grass that is the subject. You must learn to understand how the human "machine" works. The former possibility was considered by  $\operatorname{God}^1$ , but the latter case was the one He followed (in the sense of having the Israelites carried into captivity<sup>2</sup>).

They returned to watching the man in his frustration pulling the cord again and again in his attempts to start the lawnmower. He finally sprayed a special chemical into the machine and after cranking a couple of more times the engine started. He then stood straight and smiled a huge smile. There was something sweet about the sound of the mower when it starts and runs smoothly. Especially since it is now able to perform its mission, which was cutting the grass of the lawn to a reasonable level. This activity was representative of keeping his life under control, in a sense. And the aroma of new-cut grass was sort of special, too.

The mentor stopped the video and faced the group.
