#### **Thought Research Question**

What common experience did Jesus share with the visitors on the Mount of Transfiguration?

They went 40 days and nights without food:

Moses: Exodus 24:18; 34:28

(the tablets: without food and water -- twice!)

**Deuteronomy 9:9-18 (review) prostrate** 

Elijah: 1 Kings 19:8 (no food for his travel)

Jesus: Matthew 4:1-11; Mark 1:12,13; Luke 4:1-13 (no food during the temptations)

#### Moses Receives the Tablets of the Law

- When Moses went up on the mountain,
  the cloud covered it,
  and the glory of the LORD settled on Mount Sinai.
  For six days the cloud covered the mountain,
- and on the seventh day the LORD called to Moses from within the cloud.
- To the Israelites the glory of the LORD looked like a consuming fire on top of the mountain.
- Then Moses entered the cloud as he went on up the mountain.
- And he stayed on the mountain forty days and forty nights.

**Exodus 24:16, 18** 

But the Israelites had gone wild!

#### Moses Receives the Tablets of the Law

Then the LORD said to Moses,

"Write down these words,

for in accordance with these words

I have made a covenant with you and with Israel."

Moses was there with the LORD

forty days and forty nights

without eating bread or drinking water.

And he wrote on the tablets the words of the covenant — the Ten Commandments.

This time Moses face was radiant!

#### Elijah Runs for His Life to Mount Horeb

#### After the victory at the altar test Jezebel threatens Elijah

Elijah was afraid and ran for his life.

When he came to Beersheba in Judah,

he left his servant there,

while he himself went a day's journey into the desert.

He came to a broom tree,

sat down under it and prayed that he might die.

"I have had enough, LORD," he said.

"Take my life; I am no better than my ancestors."

Then he lay down under the tree and fell asleep.

Elijah tried to escape, and God helped Him

## The Temptation of Jesus

#### **After the endurance test:**

The tempter came to him and said,

"If you are the Son of God,

tell these stones to become bread."

Jesus answered,

"It is written: 'Man does not live on bread alone,
but on every word that comes

from the mouth of God."

#### Two other temptations:

- Show power by letting the angels catch him
- Offer the splendor of the world

#### **Afterword:**

Then the devil left him, and angels came and attended him.

Matthew 4:3, 11

After each man's endurance test,

God showed His presence and comforted them!

#### **Endurance in the face of other concerns**

Moses: obtaining the law of God for His people—God's presence (face radiance)

Elijah: escaped to God's presence after the altar battle – God reveals Himself gradually powerful wind, earthquake, fire, gentle whisper

Jesus: temptation as He began His mission to save us – God's absence (face radiance)
God was actually present,
but standing back and watching





# **An Early Easter**

# **The Transfiguration**

After six days [about eight days later] Jesus took with him Peter, James and John the brother of James, and led them up a high mountain by themselves [to pray].

Three: Transfiguration, healing of Jairus daughter, Garden of Gethsemane

There he was transfigured before them.

His face shone like the sun,

Whiter than anything imaginable

and his clothes became as white as the light

[his clothes became dazzling white,

whiter than anyone in the world could bleach them]

[the appearance of his face changed,

and his clothes became as bright

as a flash of lightning].

Three different views of brightness (each gospel writer)

Matthew 17:1-2, Mark 9:2-3, Luke 9:28-29

# **The Transfiguration**

```
[Peter and his companions were very sleepy,
but when they became fully awake,
they saw his glory and the two men standing with him.]

Peter said to Jesus,

 If you wish, I will put up three shelters —
      one for you,
      one for Moses and
      one for Elijah."
 [He did not know what to say, he was so frightened.]
                  Peter wanted to sustain the experience

Perhaps Peter should have offered them Food rather than try to build permanent structures!

# **The Transfiguration -- Booths**

So... after you have gathered the crops of the land, celebrate the festival to the LORD for seven days; the first day is a day of rest, and the eighth day also is a day of rest.

Live in booths for seven days:

All native-born Israelites are to live in booths so your descendants will know that I had the Israelites live in booths when I brought them out of Egypt.

I am the LORD your God.

**Leviticus 23:39, 42** 

## **The Transfiguration -- Booths**

Such booths (as are used in the feast of booths) may be what Peter had in mind when he offered to build shelters of tribute to Moses, Elijah and Jesus.

#### What is the connection?

- Celebration after the harvest
  - OT: Indication of the end of the Old Testament Age
  - NT: Celebration of the coming of the Messiah
- Remember the Temporary Housing through the Wandering
  - OT: Indication of the presence and protection by God
  - NT: God's authorization of the New Kingdom

## The Transfiguration (Summary)

- Jesus took Peter, James and John up a high mountain to pray
- Jesus was transfigured before them (face and clothes radiant)
- Peter and his companions were very sleepy, but when they became fully awake, they saw his glory and Moses and Elijah
- Moses, Elijah, and Jesus discussed the plan and upcoming events
- As the men were leaving, Peter was frightened, but offered to build shelters for each
- A bright cloud enveloped them, and God spoke His approval for His Son: "This is my Son, whom I love; Listen to him!"
- The disciples fell facedown to the ground, terrified; Jesus came and touched them, telling them not to be afraid
- When they looked up, Moses and Elijah were gone
- As they left, Jesus instructed the disciples not to tell anyone.

Jesus was not transfigures so much as the Glory was briefly revealed

#### **Other Occurrences**

- →baptism of Jesus Matthew 3:17 (transfiguration of life from carpenter to Messiah)
- →Gentiles John 12:29 (transfiguration of the definition of who are the chosen people)
- →Saul on the road to Damascus (transfiguration of a committed heart -a change in direction)

Jesus replied, "To be sure, Elijah comes [does come first]
      and will restore all things.

   In the same way [why then is it written that]
      the Son of Man
      is going to suffer at their hands [and be rejected].

Then the disciples understood that he was talking to them about John the Baptist.

## The Transfiguration Revisited

We did not follow cleverly invented stories when we told you about the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but we were eyewitnesses of his majesty.

For he received honor and glory from God the Father when the voice came to him from the Majestic Glory, saying, "This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased."

We ourselves heard this voice that came from heaven when we were with him on the sacred mountain.

Peter witnesses to this in his letters to the churches

## Stephen: a face like that of an angel

All who were sitting in the Sanhedrin looked intently at Stephen, and they saw that his face was like the face of an angel.

Acts 6:15

Stephen's face was also apparently transfigured; was this to show the live connection with God?

But the power of the image was not enough to keep the mob from stoning him. (Acts 7:54-60)

Tom Harbin: Moses and Stephen were the first and last people known to have been transfigured

## The Revelation of God's Glory

```

Christ cloaks it, but gives us a peek at the Transfiguration.

Even the glory as contained in human form is too much!

But it is the power of His Personal Presence that is key, Not the Radiance of God's Power over the Universe!

## **The Fading Radiance**

- Veil partially hides what lies behind
- Mystery something to cause us to consider what is not known
- Parables earthly stories with a heavenly meaning

#### These things are all related

Remember that Peter wanted to sustain the experience when Jesus was Transfigured and Moses and Elijah appeared

We should crave the "rush" of communion with God.

A disciple once complained,

"You tell us stories,

but you never reveal their meaning to us."

The Master replied,

"How would you like it if someone offered you fruit and chewed it up before giving it to you?"

## The Permanence of the Transfiguration

Was the Transfiguration of Christ temporary, or was it that His Glory was only revealed temporarily?

God tried direct interaction with man;
He finally sent His Son
to help us see and understand Him

We need strength from God to sustain the glory similar to the endurance given Moses, Elijah, and Jesus.

The Veil

The veil hides the true meaning, and perhaps our old physical weakness (why does a bride wear a veil?)

The Glory of the New Covenant (How can we look at the Glory?

-- sunglasses, or a veil; sunglasses that are pinholes)

# **Keeping the Law is not Simple**

People consider the 10 Commandments the "Law of God"

But it wasn't long before Moses
had to introduce a set of judges (Exodus 18:22)
to handle to the burden
of all of the legal issues of the people.

This was another sign that man cannot keep the law in a perfect way.

## Covering Everything with the Law is not Possible<sup>8</sup>

After all of the law (10 commandments and other rules) were given men, a case came up that was not covered.

The case of Zelophehad's daughters and their inheritance.

## **Transubstantiation**

Definition: the change of the substance of bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Christ occurring in the Eucharist (Communion) according to the teaching of some Christian Churches, including the Roman Catholic Church.

Is this Transfiguration? At some level?

The Bread and Wine

are symbols of the Flesh and Blood of Christ:

We don't need them to physically change -
this would limit the power of God to be with us in Spirit

This has to work in our head, not in our physical body. It is spiritual, not physical nourishment.

# **Living Water**

Jesus answered,

"Everyone who drinks this water will be thirsty again, but whoever drinks the water I give him will never thirst.

Indeed, the water I give him will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life."

John 4:13-14

We don't have to continually go somewhere and get it.
It "wells" up from within us.

# Crossing a body of water

#### Moses

crossing the Red Sea:

he kept his arms raised while the water was divided while the people of Israel passed to safety (Exodus 14:16ff)

#### Elijah

crossing the Jordan:

he rolled up his cloak and struck the water with it;

He and Elisha crossed to the place where Elijah was taken up in a fiery chariot;

the power and call of Elijah was passed on to Elisha, who also used the cloak to divide the water on the way back (2 Kings 2:8ff)

#### Jesus

crossing the Sea of Galilee:

He walked on water (would have walked by the disciples in a boat);

He encouraged Peter to get out of the boat and walk on water for a moment (the storm caused his faith to weaken) (Mark 6:45ff)

# **Transfiguring Water**

#### Moses

**Turning water into blood:** 

one of the plagues

Moses struck the water of the Nile with his staff and God turned it into blood (Exodus 7:17ff)

#### Elijah

**Burning water:** 

at the contest between Baal and God

he soaked the altar and sacrifice with water (and dug ditches to collect it) and God sent down fire to burn it all up (1 Kings 18:30ff)

#### Jesus

**Turning water into wine:** 

His first miracle

He created the best wine at the feast (at the request of his mother) (John 2:1ff)

# **Experience with Fire**

#### Moses

The Burning Bush (Exodus 3:2)

Moses interceded for the complaining people of Israel after the Lord sent fire to destroy them (Numbers 11:1-3)

#### Elijah

The altar at the contest between Baal and God

God sent down fire to burn it all up (1 Kings 18:30ff)

Fire from heaven to destroy Ahab's soldiers (2 Kings 1:10-11)

Fiery chariot to take him to the presence of God (2 Kings 2:11)

#### Jesus

Will baptize with the Holy Spirit and with fire (Luke 3:16)

Refused James and John's suggestion to bring down fire on the Samaritan city (Luke 9:54)

Will be revealed from heaven in blazing fire (2 Thessalonians 1:7)

# Those thought important in New Testament Times<sup>8</sup>

## **Herod Wonders about Jesus** Luke 9:7-9

### Peter's Confession of Christ

Luke 9:18-27; Mt 16:13-16; Mk 8:27-29

#### Who is Christ?

- John the Baptist resurrected
- Elijah appearedprophet of long ago resurrected

Why only look to the past and not the future?

The people waited for the Messiah, but were very unclear about how He would come.

# Why such interest in Elijah?

"Remember the law of my servant Moses, the decrees and laws I gave him at Horeb for all Israel. [See the connection here between Moses and Elijah]

"See, I will send you the prophet Elijah before that great and dreadful day of the LORD comes.

He will turn the hearts of the fathers to their children, and the hearts of the children to their fathers; or else I will come and strike the land with a curse."

Malachi 4:4-6

Martin Luther called it "left-handed" power.

Right-handed power consists of the blatant demonstration of power over people.

Left-handed power is the quiet demonstration of power in people, the power to stir up an appetite for God no matter what may be happening in someone's life.

Larry Crabb

Christ is the end of the law so that there may be righteousness for everyone who believes.

Moses describes in this way
the righteousness that is by the law:
"The man who does these things will live by them."

**Romans 10:4-5** 

Moses promotes righteousness from the law

## Witnesses to the Transfiguration

**God** Witnessed that Christ was His Son and Representative

- Moses and Elijah Witnessed that the Actions of Christ were in accordance with their message from God (They gave their approval)
- The three, Peter, James and John, were also witnesses to the fact that the heavenly beings gave their witness
- The other nine apostles connected this to their own witness of the ministry of Christ
- The church should also bear witness It should transform the world has it?
- Each of us should be a witness to Christ and His transforming power

#### **Witnesses**

(Moses and Elijah on the mount of transfiguration)
said to him:

'It is you who are right,

We ourselves heard this voice that came from heaven when we were with him on the sacred mountain.



Think of the awe they must have felt, in being so close to God!

## **Transfiguration Definitions**

- A marked (striking) change in form or appearance; a metamorphosis.
- A change that glorifies or exalts.
- Bible. The sudden emanation of radiance from the person of Jesus that occurred on a mountain.
- The Christian feast commemorating this event, observed on August 6 in the Roman Catholic and Anglican Churches, on August 19 in the Eastern Orthodox Church, and on the Sunday before Lent in most Protestant churches.
- The process or result of changing from one appearance, state, or phase to another: transmutation, transubstantiation.

Remember that the transfiguration of Jesus was more of a revelation of God transfigured into the form of a man

Moses: Horeb (on the Sinai peninsula); Deuteronomy 4:10 God said that he would produce a nation from Moses (after destroying the existing rebellious one)

Elijah: Horeb; 1 Kings 19:8

(Carmel was the altar contest with many people)

Elijah claimed that he was the only one

God said that he had 7000 others

Jesus: unknown, but why not Horeb? Could have been anywhere

Note that God was displeased with the people of Israel on Horeb,
But pleased with Jesus on the mount of Transfiguration!

## Some disciples eventually accomplished Peter's misguided wish

The mount of Transfiguration is thought by some to be Mt Tabor:

by the 6th century three churches stood on the summit of that isolated hill;

one for each of the booths the disciples wished to make for Jesus, Elijah, and Moses.

## Why Horeb?

Now Moses was tending the flock of Jethro his father-in-law, the priest of Midian, and he led the flock to the far side of the desert and came to Horeb, the mountain of God.

There the angel of the LORD appeared to him in flames of fire from within a bush.

Moses saw that though the bush was on fire it did not burn up.

The scapegoat was used in the Bible to take the sin out of the camp (Leviticus 16).

Jesus was the ultimate scapegoat -He stood in our place.

## Why transfigure Christ?

- To reveal the divine connection between Christ and God.
  - To show the presence of God

    To show the spiritual side of Christ
- The prophets could perform miracles, but God is pointing past them directly to Christ.
- There is a foundation of the prophets and miracles, etc, but God underlines Christ as the chosen way.
- To move the veil for a moment to show God's glory underneath
- The veil of the temple is opened as well the veil over our hearts must be eliminated.

## **Transfigured from man to God?**

- Some people think that the transfiguration marks the historical event when God became present in Christ's body
- Others think the same thing about his baptism, when the Spirit appeared as a dove and God also proclaimed His Son

This theory stems from the difficulty people have about Jesus being born as God.

They cannot accept the duality of Spirit and flesh.

Some also claim that the Spirit left Christ before he was crucified.

## **Transfigured from man to God?**

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

He was with God in the beginning.

The king's command was so urgent and the furnace so hot that the flames of the fire killed the soldiers who took up Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego, and these three men... fell into the blazing furnace. King Nebuchadnezzar leaped to his feet... and said, "Look! I see four men walking around in the fire, unbound and unharmed, and the fourth looks like a son of the gods."

The visitor is a representative of God and is not transformed This shows the power to withstand transfiguration by evil

#### **Revelation: the Container**

The physical attributes of Christ were a one-time use that fulfilled its purpose, like the first stage of a rocket delivering a payload into space.

Many things that are important to us are only the vehicles that carry something truly precious.

The body of Christ is like that –
you can think of it as the vessel designated
to deliver the unfailing love of God.

#### The Value of the Container

The human body is frail and not "God-like"; but it doesn't matter because of the worth of His perfect, pure heart.

How does the rocket designer feel?

good that the booster accomplished its mission,
not sadness that it was destroyed.

We must not be "relic" collectors.

#### **Revelation: the Container**

Which is the true gift -what is in the package
or the love behind it?

Have you ever seen small children at Christmas playing with the box and the wrappings; leaving the contents ignored.

#### **Revelation: the Conduit**

#### **Revelation: the Communion**

What do we revere?

When we enjoy the communion, perhaps we should not consider his body and blood something as sacred as the love that flowed through them.

Are we sure that we are paying our real tribute to the power of the love that flowed through them?

We must revere only what is of real value.

## Revelation of Love: the Body and Blood

The Body is a vital, suffering part of God's Love – not just a symbol... The communion is not a sacred transubstantiation, but something to help us remember the power of love. We think mostly of the blood (life) because of its cleansing power; but the body represents the feeling and suffering; We need to transfer an understanding of the feelings that Christ felt in that body The body of Christ converted God's love into something that we could see and feel. This was a transfiguration of spirit into something physical that we can better understand.

#### The Communion aids in our Sustainment

We must let the true Radiance of God shine through the Body of Christ.

The Transfiguration of Jesus needs to occur regularly in our hearts.

The Communion is a part of that process; opening the veil between ourselves and God.

## What is the most Precious Substance? What could God use to draw us to Him?

What is the most precious substance that exists?

Could God have done something

with gold or silver to show His love for us?

What is truly precious to us?

What can be more precious than Life?
What physical substance can exhibit Life
more than that of blood?

We cannot transmute lead into gold,
but we can change our hearts
from stone (dead) to flesh (living)
And respond to the Greatest Gift that could be given.

but to make us a part of something awesome
and awe-inspiring;

## **King Saul**

# Saul was Transfigured

Saul was chosen by God to be king (evidently because he was a head taller than anyone else). He was very humble in the beginning,

but he still had to be transfigured.

The Spirit of the LORD will come upon you in power, and you will prophesy with them; and you will be changed into a different person.

1 Samuel 10:6

As Saul turned to leave Samuel, God changed Saul's heart

He was given a great opportunity

1 Samuel 10:9

# **But Saul could not stay Transfigured (1)**

God changed Saul's heart for Good, but it changed back at some point.

I am grieved that I have made Saul king, because he has turned away from me and has not carried out my instructions.

# Saul could not stay Transfigured (2)

They danced and sang:

He was prophesying in his house, while David was playing the harp, as he usually did.

Saul had a spear in his hand and he hurled it, saying to himself, "I'll pin David to the wall."

But David eluded him twice.

# Saul could not stay Transfigured (3)

Saul was afraid of David,

because the LORD was with David but had left Saul.

1 Samuel 18:12

But an evil spirit from the LORD came upon Saul

as he was sitting in his house with his spear in his hand.

Is Saul consumed with war, paranoid, or just murderous in heart?

While David was playing the harp,

Saul tried to pin him to the wall with his spear,

but David eluded him

as Saul drove the spear into the wall.

- "Now get up and go into the city, and you will be told what you must do."
- The men traveling with Saul stood there speechless; they heard the sound but did not see anyone.
- Saul got up from the ground, but when he opened his eyes he could see nothing.

So they led him by the hand into Damascus.

For three days he was blind, and did not eat or drink anything.

## **Another Saul was Transfigured (4)**

Then Ananias went to the house and entered it.

Placing his hands on Saul, he said,
"Brother Saul, the Lord — Jesus,

as you were coming here —

Immediately, something like scales fell from Saul's eyes, and he could see again.

# **Our Sinful Nature Must be Changed (1)**

Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus, because through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit of life set me free from the law of sin and death.

For what the law was powerless to do in that it was weakened by the sinful nature, God did by sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful man to be a sin offering.

And so he condemned sin in sinful man, in order that the righteous requirements of the law might be fully met in us, who do not live according to the sinful nature but according to the Spirit.

**Romans 8:1-4** 

# Our Sinful Nature Must be Changed (2)

Those who live according to the sinful nature have their minds set on what that nature desires; but those who live in accordance with the Spirit have their minds set on what the Spirit desires.

The mind of sinful man is death, but the mind controlled by the Spirit is life and peace; the sinful mind is hostile to God.

It does not submit to God's law, nor can it do so.

Those controlled by the sinful nature cannot please God.

Have you ever hoped for this to happen to you?

- I have been waiting for this to happen to me for years. Now I am too old for it to mean anything.
- But I have finally found satisfaction in knowing that while I may be an Ugly Duckling to the world, I can be a beautiful swan to God.
- God doesn't care what I look like, but what I think like, and act like.
- I can control that better than I can my looks, though I agree with Abraham Lincoln when he said that any man over 40 is responsible for the way that he looks.

The theme of the Ugly Duckling is transformation; changing from that which is inferior or appears to be inferior to that which is superior.

Caution: We sometimes have a tendency to show people what a beautiful swan we have become.

The Transfiguration is not about us (and our own glory)!

God can cause a great transformation in our lives.

He can change our night into day, simply by helping us to reproduce His Goodness in our own hearts.

Our life before Christ enters in is full of sin and ugly, very similar to the ugly duckling.

Christ can remove guilty feelings in our life, remove our sins, create in us a new heart and attitude, gives us purpose.

He cleanses us completely.

While being changed, we may feel like a shapeless mass.

The ugly larva in its cocoon spends much time in almost unnoticeable growth and change.

## The Ugly Duckling - Secret Identity?

Superman had his Clark Kent, for example, who was looked down on because of his 'mild mannered nature' and general look of weakness.

We must realize, though, that Superman lived by the same principles even when he was dressed as Clark Kent.

No matter what we look like to others, we must always follow the Way of God.

## **Christ as the Ugly Duckling**

In a way, Christ himself was an ugly duckling.

Even though he was God he was born into the world as a tiny infant, needing the constant care of his parents.

He grew up as normally as possible, so that in his own home town of Nazareth he could not be though of as great.

Now at the name of Jesus every knee will bow.

# **Christ as the Ugly Duckling**

We are transfigured by being in the presence of God; we are changed from a weed that would otherwise be cast into the fire. God gives us value.

#### Do we reflect the seed that God planted?

Jesus told them another parable:

- "The kingdom of heaven is like a man who sowed good seed in his field.
- But while everyone was sleeping,
  - his enemy came and sowed weeds among the wheat, and went away.
- When the wheat sprouted and formed heads, then the weeds also appeared.
- "The owner's servants came to him and said,
  'Sir, didn't you sow good seed in your field?
  Where then did the weeds come from?'
- "'An enemy did this,' he replied.

Matthew 13:24-28a

### Do we reflect the seed that God planted?

"The servants asked him,

## The Man at the Pool (1)

Some time later,

Jesus went up to Jerusalem for a feast of the Jews.

Now there is in Jerusalem near the Sheep Gate a pool, which in Aramaic is called Bethesda and which is surrounded by five covered colonnades.

Here a great number of disabled people used to lie—the blind, the lame, the paralyzed.

One who was there had been an invalid for thirty-eight years.

When Jesus saw him lying there and learned that he had been in this condition for a long time, he asked him,

"Do you want to get well?"

John 5:1-6

This man had been waiting for 38 years to be changed.

## The Man at the Pool (2)

```
"Sir," the invalid replied,

"I have no one to help me into the pool
when the water is stirred.

While I am trying to get in,
someone else goes down ahead of me."
```

Then Jesus said to him,
"Get up! Pick up your mat and walk."
At once the man was cured;
he picked up his mat and walked.

John 5:7-9

The stirred waters of the pool played no real part in this miracle.

## The Man at the Pool (3)

The day on which this took place was a Sabbath, and so the Jews said to the man who had been healed,

"It is the Sabbath; the law forbids you to carry your mat."

John 5:10

The man was Transfigured in body, and hopefully in spirit.

Those who watched, however, were not changed and demonstrated their lack of willingness to understand.

## The Man at the Pool (4)

But he replied,

"The man who made me well said to me, 'Pick up your mat and walk.' "

So they asked him,

"Who is this fellow who told you to pick it up and walk?"

The man who was healed had no idea who it was, for Jesus had slipped away into the crowd that was there.

John 5:11-13

Transfiguration meant nothing to the Pharisees.

## The Man at the Pool (5)

Later Jesus found him at the temple and said to him, "See, you are well again.

Stop sinning or something worse may happen to you."

The man went away and told the Jews that it was Jesus who had made him well.

Jesus wanted to make sure that the Spiritual change was permanent.

The analogy of the seed that is planted and that produces something totally different!

It must change completely.

[2 Corinthians 15]

This applies to the resurrection of the body as well as to changes needed in our hearts.

We will be changed into the spiritual image of Christ.

We must be changed to an imperishable (and pure nature) to enable us to live with God.

#### The New Birth Parallels Christ's Experience (1) 20

What shall we say, then?

We died to sin; how can we live in it any longer?
Or don't you know that all of us
who were baptized into Christ Jesus
were baptized into his death?

We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life.

#### A Transfiguration to Become Like Christ (2)

Not that I have already obtained all this, or have already been made perfect, but I press on to take hold of that for which Christ Jesus took hold of me.

I do not consider myself yet to have taken hold of it.

But one thing I do:

Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead,

People did not want to get near him

#### The Transfiguration of Legion (5)

Those who had seen it told the people how the demon-possessed man had been cured.

Then all the people of the region of the Gerasenes asked Jesus to leave them, because they were overcome with fear.

So he got into the boat and left.

They were afraid either way!

Luke 8:36-37

These people saw the awesome power to change for Good, and they did not want it!

Jesus did not stay where he was not wanted.

Sometimes we cannot stand change or success!

#### The Transfiguration of Legion (6)

#### From Stone to Flesh (1)

I will give them an undivided heart and put a new spirit in them;

I will remove from them their heart of stone and give them a heart of flesh.

Then they will follow my decrees and be careful to keep my laws.

They will be my people, and I will be their God.

**Ezekiel 11:19-20** 

This is a serious Transfiguration.

#### From Stone to Flesh (2)

# The Transfiguration of Rehoboam (2)

When the LORD saw that they humbled themselves, this word of the LORD came to Shemaiah:

"Since they have humbled themselves,
I will not destroy them
but will soon give them deliverance.
My wrath will not be poured out on Jerusalem through Shishak.

They will, however,
become subject to him,
so that they may learn the difference
between serving me
and serving the kings of other lands."
1 Chronicles 12-8

### The Transfiguration of Rehoboam (3)

When Shishak king of Egypt attacked Jerusalem, he carried off the treasures of the temple of the LORD and the treasures of the royal palace.

He took everything, including the gold shields Solomon had made.

Because Rehoboam humbled himself, the LORD's anger turned from him, and he was not totally destroyed.

Indeed, there was some good in Judah.

1 Chronicles 12:9, 12

A spark!

One generation: from the richest nation, Rehoboam lost 10 tribes and all the gold!

Did Rehoboam stay Transfigured?

# The Transfiguration of Manasseh (1)

Manasseh... did evil in the eyes of the LORD, following the detestable practices of the nations the LORD had driven out before the Israelites...

He bowed down to all the starry hosts and worshiped them.

He sacrificed his sons in the fire in the Valley of Ben Hinnom,

He worshipped everything but God

practiced sorcery, divination and witchcraft, and consulted mediums and spiritists.

He did much evil in the eyes of the LORD, provoking him to anger.

1 Chronicles 33:1ff

### The Transfiguration of Manasseh (2)

The LORD spoke to Manasseh and his people, but they paid no attention.

So the LORD brought against them
the army commanders of the king of Assyria,
who took Manasseh prisoner,
put a hook in his nose,
bound him with bronze shackles
and took him to Babylon.

In his distress he sought the favor of the LORD his God and humbled himself greatly before the God of his fathers.

1 Chronicles 33:10-12

# The Transfiguration of Manasseh (3)

And when he prayed to him,

Nathan replied,

"The LORD has taken away your sin.

You are not going to die.

But because by doing this you have made the enemies of the LORD show utter contempt, the son born to you will die."

# The Transfiguration of David (3)

After Nathan had gone home,

# Cleansed by the Blood of Christ (1)

When Christ came as high priest
of the good things that are already here,
he went through the greater
and more perfect tabernacle that is not man-made,
that is to say, not a part of this creation.

He did not enter by means of the blood of goats and calves;

but he entered the Most Holy Place once for all by his own blood, having obtained eternal redemption.

# Cleansed by the Blood of Christ (2)

## **Tongues of Flame (1)**

## **Tongues of Flame (2)**

Now there were staying in Jerusalem God-fearing Jews from every nation under heaven.

When they heard this sound,

## **A Dramatic Change**

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toward God.

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
We must be cleaned completely through and through!

Not just on the surface!

A significant effort is made in the semiconductor industry to create extremely pure substances. But impurities cannot be completely kept out.

- water vapor is everywhere
- gases permeate through neoprene seals
- hydrogen can actually permeate through metals

#### We may have to look very hard at ourselves



The way you look at an object can reveal contaminants that are not normally seen under other conditions (PDE):

- 1) Bright light
- 2) Oblique angle
- 3) Other wavelength (infrared, etc)



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


Based on the idea of perfect geometric figures, man decided that the orbits of the planets were pure circles.

## We must be careful of preconceived ideas (2)



The data didn't fit the theory, so more pure circles were added.

## We must be careful of preconceived ideas (3)



Better to let the truth surface as it is -- the planets orbit in ellipses (elongated circles).

Do we do the same thing with Scripture and God?

Do we let our mind suggest -that since God is Perfect Love,
that he <u>has</u> to forgive us no matter what we do?

We have a great capacity to out-think ourselves!

#### Man can pervert the greatest principles!

Consider: This country was founded on the idea of freedom

A pure and perfect idea!

And yet it maintained the evil of slavery (for those not worthy)

How could the fathers of the country have so badly missed their own point!



# **Created to Soar (2)**

The alula is a small projection on the forward edge of the wing of birds. It is actually one of the bird's digits, and is typically covered with three to five small feathers. This functions in the same way as the slats on the wing of an aircraft, allowing the wing to achieve a higher than normal angle of attack and thus lift without resulting in a stall.



# **Created to Soar (3)**
