Mind and Heart, or Heart (not Mind) over Matter (Comm)

We worship God as the Creator of this vast Universe. That makes Him awesome beyond our understanding. But how do we respond to that aspect of Him? Are we to go forth and create things in our worship of Him?

Well, maybe. But we must also realize that He is the God of Love. This more truly reveals His character, and it gives us much more of a goal to shoot for. The creation was made only because He needed to create a home for the object of His Love (us).

Was Love a part of creation? No, it is an eternal. God didn't create love – God <u>is</u> Love (1 John 4:8).

So do we create in response, or do we Love in response to God?

It is sort of a question of mind or heart. We cannot possibly imitate the mind and power of God. If we could, of what use would it be?

We cannot imitate His heart either, fully, but we have a much better chance of being like Him in this sense. We have trouble loving every person on earth, but we are certainly capable of loving our neighbors and humanity in general. We create love, in a sense, by generating or producing it in relation to those around us.

I try to study and get into the mind of God, but the important thing is to get into His heart. And the best way I know of for us to do that is to engage ourselves fully into this act of communion with the Son that He gave as a sacrifice to show His unfailing and overflowing love.

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- 1 Cor 8:1; knowledge puffs up while love builds up 1 Cor 13: If we have knowledge, but have not love, we are nothing.
