A French philosopher once said that some people are always seeking something to keep their mind occupied, so that they don't have to think about themselves. They are afraid to look at themselves. They are afraid to look at themselves because they are afraid to think of what is there. They know that their lives are empty, dark and insignificant.

I believe that there are those here tonight who try to hide from themselves their own lost state. I feel that these people don't realize the part that God should play in their lives, and whenever they think of their sin, they quickly find something else to think about. But if our life seems empty, the Bible says, we can be filled with the Holy Spirit. If our life is dark, we should let Christ be our light. If we feel insignificant, we are told that we can be children and heirs of God. And most important of all, if we are lost in sin, we find that our heavenly Father will forgive us if we only trust in him and do his will.
